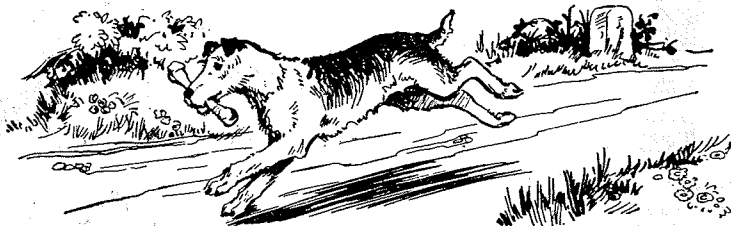


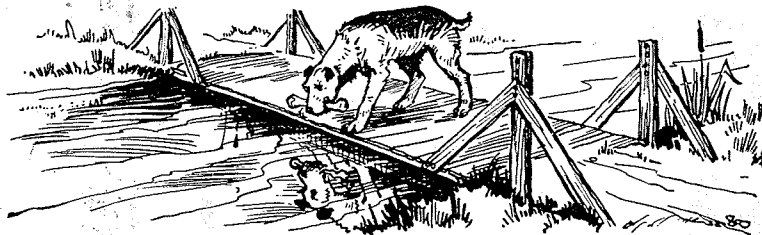
THE GREEDY DOG

The other dog had also a bone in his mouth.

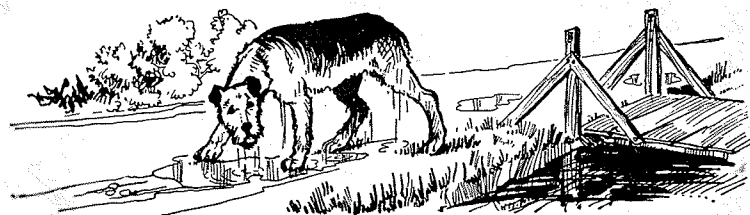
THE GREEDY DOG

Now he had no bone at all.

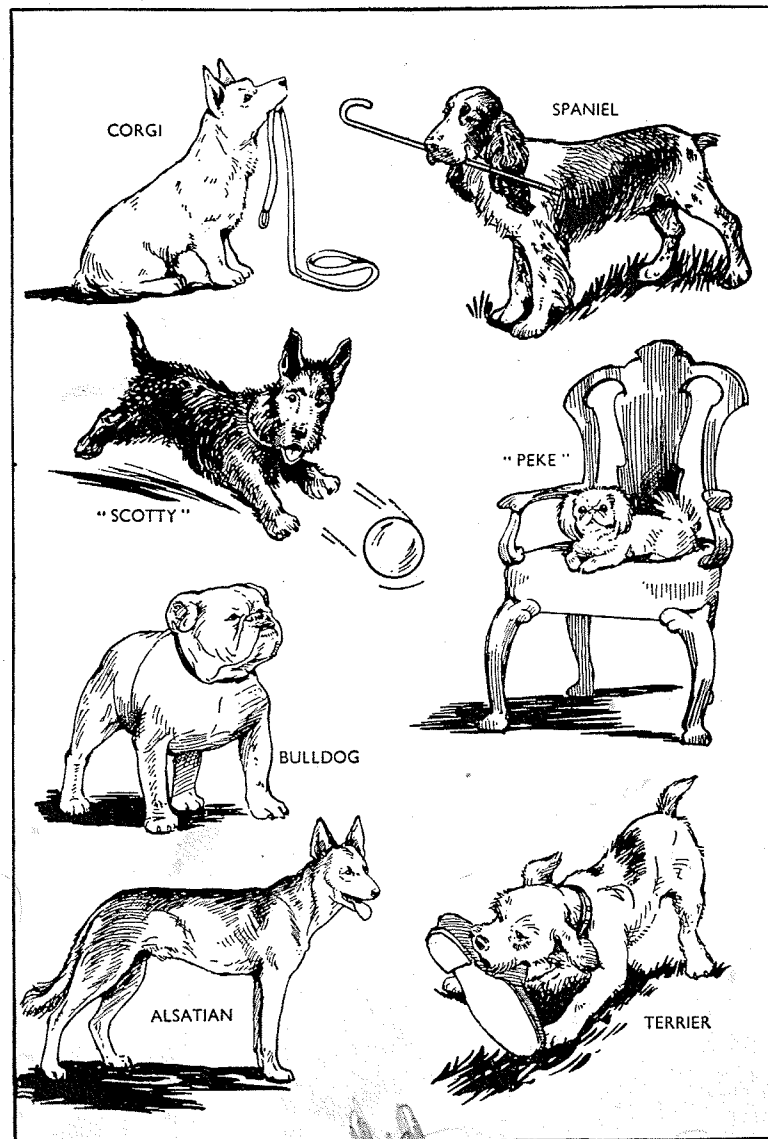

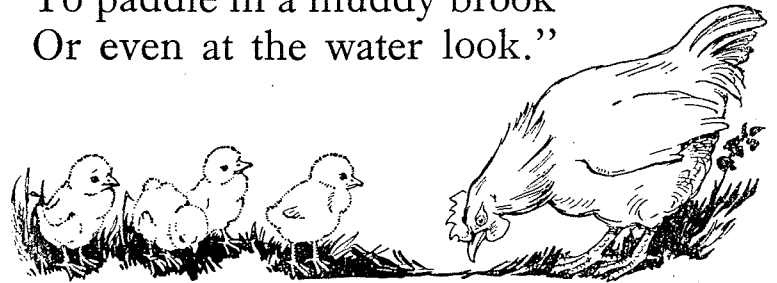
